16/03CT MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

Minutes of the meeting held on 11TH NOVEMBER 2015 were proposed, seconded approved and signed.

Mr B MacKay asked questions and made allegations about lack of action by the City Council regarding the former TIC and provision of visitor information. He then left the room.

16/05CT PRESENTATION

The Wells October Festivals: 'City of Culture'. Representatives spoke about the festivals, and the difficulties in putting on these events. They had particular practical concerns with rubbish collections, parking and traffic arrangements. There were also needs for assistance with publicity, branding and marketing. There was a general sharing of information and ideas culminating in a discussion about the need for a town centre manager.

It was proposed, seconded and agreed to put forward a request for the City Council to consider appointing a city centre manager, with the idea that the main commercial partners would contribute joint shares of the cost.

City centre flags: up-date

The RFO reported on costs and options. It was agreed to request a budget of £500 from the City Centre and Open Spaces Committee, to cover the costs of Union flags and bunting; these can be put up by the City Council Open Spaces Team and will be in place from mid-April to mid-June, covering the period of the celebrations.

It was agreed to ask that the Mayor write to the Queen inviting Her to attend the celebrations in the smallest city in England (Lord Lieutenant to be notified); or one of the Royal family, if she is unable to attend.

ii. Wells Cinema film festival

Mr Cooper gave a summary of the very exciting plans for the weekend of 21st – 23rd April.

iii. Information from parish of St Cuthbert Out

Cllr Reeves reported on plans to take part in the lighting of beacons at high points in the surrounding area, on 21st April. It was felt this was a good idea but that there was not any obvious way for Wells to be involved; the focus will be on the film festival during the evenings.

iv. Clean for the Queen

The Chairman reported that U3A are intending to take part in this national campaign. The committee welcomed this initiative. MDC will be providing equipment; please contact the Town Clerk if you are aware of any other groups in the City planning to take part.
