'Visit by Coach' progress up-date:

A report had been circulated by e-mail; Mr Webb and Mr Johns provided further details. Improving the visitor arrival experience at the bus station, and the links with coach drivers, were important points.

There was a discussion about future management of an increase in coach numbers.

All agreed that Mr Jeffries has a positive, active approach and that input from some one new coming from outside is proving very beneficial.

#### 16/54CT V.I.S. (VISITOR INFORMATION SERVICE) PROPOSALS

Mr Webb had circulated his proposals and had replied to questions by e-mail. He said that he would value informal input of views from a broader cross section of stakeholders. He answered further questions and there was discussion around various formats. The Town Clerk answered questions about the procedures for local council committees and sub-committees, and accountability for public funds. Members felt that there was no need to set up another group and there was a reluctance to attend more, duplicate, meetings. It was agreed that informal discussions follow on from the Forum meetings.
