Wells Twinning Association, town-twinning visit November 2018: Information and a budget for the event had been provided by the Wells Twinning Association; Cllr North was present as representative and answered questions. Proposed, seconded and agreed: £589.

18/99F MATTERS OF URGENT REPORT

i. Cllr Price gave an up-date on the <u>67 bus route</u>: there had been two meetings and three amendments to the route including the addition of a stop at Wells Market Place.

There appears to be some S.106 funding from the Bovis Homes development in St Cuthbert Out parish.

Cllr Price asked for a budget allocation and was asked to bring a specific proposal to the next meeting.

ii. <u>Cross-street wires</u>

The Chairman reported there has been further damaged to the wires across the High Street and to the front of properties, due to mis-use by third parties putting up advertising banners.

The City Council is looking into the costs to public money of the necessary repairs and will discuss a way forward to support the community events to put up their banners safely.

18/100F PROPERTIES

Post Office lease:

Post Office Ltd has asked for a further lease extension of three months. After consideration, it was agreed to suggest that a longer extension might be preferred, as there are legal costs to every renewal, at public expense.

ii. The Council has completed repairs to damage at the Post Office due to water seepage.
