Skateboard Park

Work scheduled to be carried out on enclosing the open sides of three ramps with galvanised steel mesh.

Anti social activity reported to Police, resulting in increased visits from the beat officer. Boundary hedges/scrubland cut back.

Daily safety inspections taking place, including clearing rubbish and litter picking.

Relief Road / Maintenance

Two further dog waste bins installed at various locations.

Allotments
