Neighbourhood Plan Report

The Referendum held on 25 January received 1114 votes in favour of the Neighbourhood Plan, 255 against.

Regarding next steps, the Plan carries weight in the planning system the day the result is declared. It is then down to Somerset Council to go through the formalities to "make" the Plan. It is expected that the Plan will be made on 14th February. The Steering Group met for the last time on 31 January to look at the 10 projects that have been identified within the Plan. The minutes will follow from this meeting. Denise Denis thanked Adrian l'Anson for his dedication and hard work to keep the Plan on track and for his knowledge and expertise.

I propose that the Neighbourhood Plan should remain as a standing item on the Planning Committee Agenda, with the projects to be considered by Full Council.
