There was a long discussion of the presentation paper. The representatives were in strong support of the proposal; it appeared that some groups were willing to put in financial support. Andy Webb said he could gain funding from Mendip Tourism Ltd by diverting it from other projects.

The Chairman asked everyone to submit bullet points to the Town Clerk for a remit to be discussed at the next meeting; it was agreed to meet again soon. There were concerns about the coach bay in Sadler Street and discussion of the need for free parking for coaches at the bus station. (Cllr Cox left the meeting)

16/29CT ANY OTHER MATTERS OF REPORT

- It was agreed to keep the flags and bunting up in the town until the end of August.
- ii. The Open Spaces Officer reported there had been no suggestion that the cost of maps be reduced, but he had checked with Cityscape; there would be a financial cost involved. Sales are doing very well at the current price. The Waitrose site is far the best seller, followed by Cathedral Green, with the High Street the least.
- A request that the Bishops Palace stop bill-posting on empty shops iii. and on the map boards.
- It was agreed that a representative from the Film Centre be formally iv. co-opted onto the Forum.
- Cllr Swain asked if members would support raising the LGBT flag at ٧. the Town Hall, in solidary with victims of the Orlando killings. All those present indicated their support.
